

CONSTRUCTION WORKS NOTIFICATION – EAST WEST INTERCONNECTOR – FINGAL

July 23rd, 2010

As promised, we are writing to you to advise you of road works to install the East West Interconnector that will be taking place in the Fingal area.

The Interconnector cables will come ashore at Rush North Beach, Co. Dublin, and then continue underground to Woodland in Co. Meath.

EirGrid has liaised with Fingal County Council to ensure traffic disruption is kept to a minimum.

Area:	On the road West of the M1, heading towards Ballyboughal between Thomondtown and Gracedieu
Start Date:	26.07.2010
Times:	08.00 to 18.00
Expected duration	1 Week
Description	The works will involve trenching for two hundred metres. A single lane closure will be in place for these works. The carriage way will be left free for two way traffic outside of working hours.

The main contract for the Interconnector was awarded to **ABB**, who have sub-contracted the cable installation work to **VolkerInfra**, a company that has significant expertise in the installation of cables in the UK. **GMC** will undertake the ducting work in Fingal.

We are working closely with Fingal County Council to complete this work with as little disruption as possible although we do appreciate that any project of this scale will impact day to day life in the area.
